Here's how it works

A user who has located a reference to a journal article needs the full text of the article along with other directly related information. The following series of SirsiDynix Resolver actions retrieves the desired information:

- The user clicks on the citation for the desired article, sending to SirsiDynix Resolver an OpenURL, which contains descriptive details about the article, known as metadata, such as author, volume number, etc.
- SirsiDynix Resolver translates the metadata and applies a set of rules to determine what sources and services to offer the user that are available from the Web or from the physical library, and then returns these selections.
- From a single inquiry, the user may receive links to full-text journal articles, and other resources such as reviews, contact information, full-text white papers, resources in the library's catalog, and more.
